# 1. Platform sign-in



To start using platform functionality, any participant should register on the platform first:

- Go to Moodle website: <https://seed.vma.liedm.lt/>
- Go to *Log in button*
- Click *Create new account* and fill in the required fields
- Confirm the email in your inbox
- If everything is correct, participant will see a success message on the platform

## 2. Course enrolment



To explore platform capabilities, participants should enrol in a course either a student or a teacher:

- Sign in to the platform

- Click *Design Thinking Lab course*
- Consider a role participant to play on the course – *Student or a Teacher*
- Click button *Enrol me to finish the process*

# 5. SEED Guide

SEED Guide is a teacher's handbook that:

- Gives an overview of platform materials, including each challenge
- Provided detailed instructions on how to work with interactive platform templates

## 6. SEED Design Thinking Canvas (SEED DTC)

This is the core interactive element of the course that is made as a challenge template. It allows students to save the notes while going through each challenge:

- Challenge draft notes can be saved at any moment
- Each note content is visible to other group members and can be edited by them
- Challenge notes could be deleted if no longer required
- Note: If the teacher creates a template instead of a student, students won't be able to access it.

For ease of use, DTC contains links to other interactive templates that are in or outside the platform and links to SEED Guide when necessary.

# 7. How to export and import course to own Moodle

To **“export”** course you need to go under “Administration” section of the course click “Backup” link, choose all necessary resources, click “next” and download it.

To **“import”** course – create empty course, turn editing on, under “Administration” section choose “Restore”, choose downloaded backup file, click “Restore”, click “next”, then choose “Delete the contents of this course and then restore”, click “Continue”.
